

Points to note

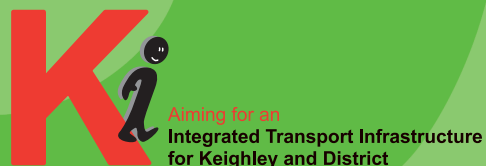

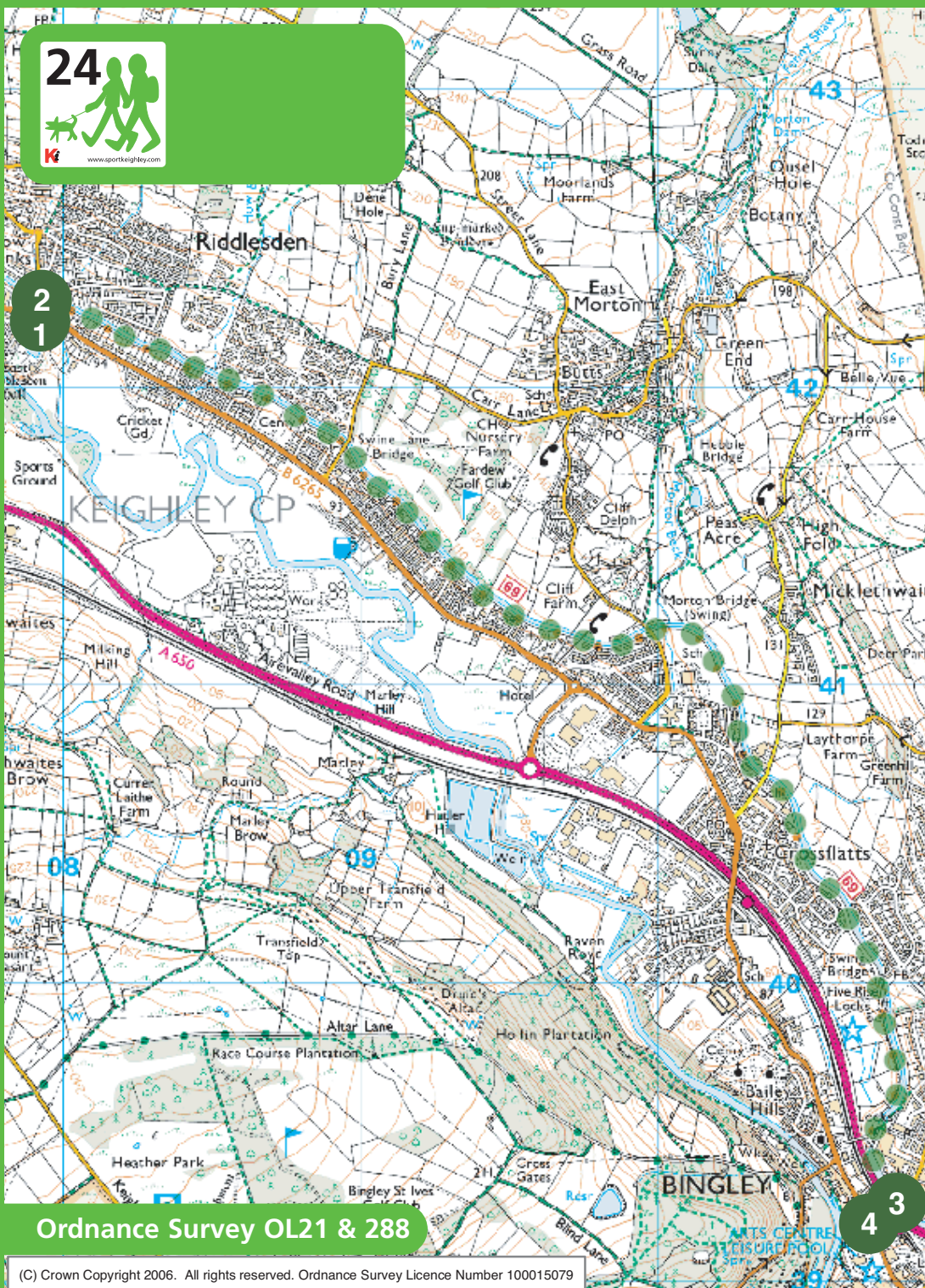

The Route:

- 1 Catch the Bradford shuttle bus ask for the stop opposite East Riddlesden Hall - Granby Lane
(If you wish to visit East Riddlesden Hall before the walk, cross over at the crossing and go in to the grounds of East Riddlesden Hall on the left. Explore the gardens for free; there is also café and toilets. Please note there is a charge to look around the hall OPEN April - October).

After visiting the hall retrace your steps out of the grounds and back across the road.)

- 2 From the bus stop turn left walking along the road just a short way to Granby Lane, here turn left to walk up Granby lane to the canal bank.
- 3 Turn right cross the road and walk on to the canal, now walk along the towpath of the Leeds Liverpool canal all the way to Bingley.

You will cross:

- Under Swine lane continue on the canal to
- Morton lane continue on the canal to
- Micklethwaite lane continue on the canal towpath to the Five Rise locks.

From the five rise locks follow the path down to the right of the locks and continue along the canal towpath to the 3 rise locks, here at the locks you cross the canal on the

small bridge on the left and then turn right to walk down to the bottom of the lock, turning left at the bottom follow the path now on the other side of the canal along and up to Park Road.

- 4 On Park Road turn right and walk on Park road up to Main Street Bingley.

Here you will find shops and cafés, to return to keighley cross over Main Street to the bus stop.
